Salute to Frank Viola for some fuel starter for today's WOW. God's wisdom, 3000+ years ago, ancient Israel was instructed to do something that we modern human beings are desperate to learn—how to reboot, how to to hit the reset button. Yobel, ram's horn trumpet, announcement of beginning of 50<sup>th</sup> year, Year of Jubilee.

Old Testament. Year of Jubilee, every 50 years. Jubilee was not just another religious holiday, ceremony, time off work. Jubilee was a radical reboot. Liberty, release of slaves, return of property.

Consider: debts were forgiven. Slaves were freed. Land was returned to original families. Forgiveness, freedom, restoration, renewal.

Deliverance, Equality, Forgiveness, Freedom, Provision, Release, Renewal, Rest, Restoration, Security.

For Christians, Jesus is our Jubilee. He offers a hard reset. He began his ministry (Luke 4) with promises from Isaiah 61—release, healing, liberty. Some stories we know well. Peter gets to start over. A woman is told to go and sin no more. Another woman is changed because of her Jesus encounter. The gospel accounts are filled with Jesus encounters, the list goes on and on...

In Jubilee, what was lost gets restored. That is indeed Good News! The Bible calls it salvation! The old goes away, the new comes. Freedom replaces slavery. Forgiveness eliminates sin-slavery.
