**Expectation**

"In the morning, O Lord, you hear my voice; in the morning I lay my requests before you and wait in expectation." (Ps. 5:3)

Does God hear your voice in the morning?

Do you lay your requests and needs before him? What do you pray about? Do you pray about his priorities, his will? What if we were praying as hard for the lost as we are for the sick? What if we prayed as hard about salvation of the lost as we do about their physical needs and hurts?
