THINGS TO CONSIDER WHEN STUDYING THE BIBLE

- Who is doing the speaking and to whom are the words being spoken?
- What circumstances in the context might affect the meaning?
- Is the language to be understood in a literal or figurative sense?
- Partial truth can lead to wrong conclusions. Correct understanding occurs only when all verses dealing with a subject are considered.
- More difficult passages must be understood in a way that harmonizes (agrees) with less difficult passages.
- Bible study must be undertaken with an open mind not prejudiced by opinions or preconceived ideas.

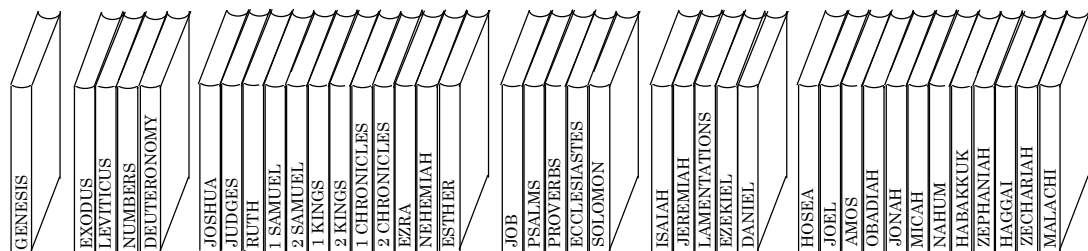
