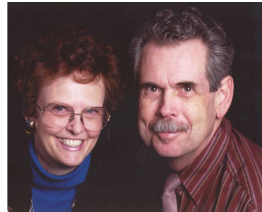

2010 summer-fall schedule almost full—limited dates remain!

Now scheduling 2011 Seminars, Workshops, and Mission Trips

U pdate! Due to the way the 2010 schedule has filled, we have agreed with the local church to adjust our ministry commitments and begin our expanded ministry and mission focus **effective September 1**. We will serve the local church in a part-time ministry role, but will spend much of our time helping churches (in the U.S. and the mission field) with seminars and workshops. We will also increase our efforts on behalf of Baxter Institute. **A few 2010 dates remain.** We will be honored to visit your church to encourage missions or to assist with a seminar. 2010 Plans

W e will be in Honduras for most of May, teaching at Seminario Baxter and visiting and working with various Honduran mission efforts. My assigned topic at Seminario is “The Role of the Holy Spirit in Acts and the Spread of Christianity in the Early Church.” Our 2010 schedule will take us back to Honduras at least once more, and we plan to spend about three weeks serving and ministering in Peru. In addition, we have visits and commitments planned and scheduled with US churches. We can take a limited number of group members on some mission trips—if you would like to participate in a future trip, please let us know as soon as possible.



2010 Activities

Although my weekly ministry obligations for teaching and preaching in the local congregation have occupied much of my time during the first four months of the year, the year has gotten off to a good start with various ministry and missions activities.

- Presented a weekend leadership workshop
- Several opportunities to speak about missions, especially about Baxter
- The **Main and Oklahoma church** raised a special gift of \$2000+ for Baxter Institute
- Monitoring construction of president's house at Baxter with review of plans, contracts, expenses, and other details
- Finished writing Strategic Planning document for Baxter Institute
- Reviewed and reconstructed major portions of the Baxter website
- Prepared Spanish materials for Baxter Seminario and other scheduled speaking appointments
- Recorded another 13-lesson Video Series for New Life Behavior prison ministries, for use in the prison work
- Church and church leadership consulting
