God's Presence: Removing the Veil to See Christ Clearly (The Unveiled Christ) 2 Cor 3:14-18 Bob Young

A time of spiritual renewal is upon us—we live in a culture/world that wants to experience God.

- 1. This text is part of the Corinthian correspondence with a strong emphasis on Christ (see 1 Cor. 2:1-2; 2 Cor. 1:19-22).
- 2. Chapters 2-7 provide a strong theology of ministry.
- 3. In chap. 3, the Old Testament parallel text is Exodus 34

How does one experience Christ?

- 1. Turn to God, veil lifts
- 2. God then turns us into his likeness

Re: #1: Let go, release, this is not about performance where one lives under the veil, find the new Kingdom, let go of the kingdom of self.

Re: #2: This is God's movement, not ours, a little at a time, almost imperceptible, glory to glory, little by little

Paul gives three examples of the process:

- 3:1-3 Our hearts are changed as God writes on our hearts by the HS
- 3:4-6 Our competence/dependency is changed by God's life changing HS
- 3:7-11 Our righteousness is changed by the HS
